The Inactive Hazardous Sites Branch (the Branch) is in receipt of your letter dated April 15, 2011. Based on information previously submitted, this Site was added to the Branch's inventory of sites on October 6, 2010. The site is currently listed in the Evaluations Pending category of the Branch's inventory and has not been prioritized for action. When resources become available, Branch staff will prepare a site ranking and the site will be placed on the Branch's Sites Priority List (SPL) unless you have entered the REC Program or submitted a No Further Action review request.
