
I am writing in response to your January 24, 2011 Notice of REC Program Eligibility – Time Extension letter for The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC) Cogeneration Facility Warehouse.

As outlined in my correspondence dated January 14, 2011, initial excavation of soils impacted by suspect material within the building footprint was conducted between October 26, 2010 and November 6, 2010. Supplemental excavation events were conducted on December 13, 2010, January 4, 2011, and April 6 through 8, 2011 to remove additional soils proximate to but outside of the new warehouse footprint.

UNC respectfully requests an extension until July 18, 2011 to make a decision regarding entry into the Registered Environmental Consultant (REC) program. This additional time is needed to conduct laboratory analyses, and to compile data from the abatement phases conducted thus far.
