

MINUTES  
OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH and CLINICAL SAFETY COMMITTEE  
March 22, 2018

1. Review and approval of minutes from December 14, 2017 meeting.
2. Dr. James Hill provided an update of the standardized training program for University credentialed personnel practicing at all UNC Healthcare facilities.
  - a. Current the Tuberculosis (TB) and Bloodborne Pathogen training units have been rewritten
  - b. Goal is to have less slides in the training units and add more resources
  - c. Determination on accessing records for compliance with University Policies and outside agencies (OSHA) pending process.
3. Dr. James Hill discussed the use of Blood test vs the TB Skin Test due to false positive testing results from skin testing alone. Issue would affect Subcommittee members in Allied Health. Currently, Campus Health Services are providing the blood test for TB verification at the current time.
4. Martin Folliard, Department of Clinical Affairs, School of Dentistry provided an update on the integration of student tracking with Environment Health and Safety system. Mr. Folliard outlines that the integration must provide the following:
  - a. Tracking safety training
  - b. HIPPA compliance
  - c. Security awareness
  - d. Internal Medical Emergency training
  - e. Consolidation of records
5. Discussion concerning migration of School of Medicine training requirements for credentialed personnel to a single gatekeeper. Group is currently waiting on feedback from healthcare.
6. Activity outlined for discussion from subcommittee:
  - a. Vaccination requirements for Tetanus

- b. Need to capture Health and Safety data on Bloodborne Pathogen exposures
  - c. Influenza data and compliance
- Committee further agreed that the communication for the subcommittee must contain standard language. Lastly, it was noted that Dr. Weber's resource concerning Yellow Fever and travel immunization was available at Campus Health Services.

- 7. Updates from the University Safety and Security Committee:
  - a. Asbestos awareness and removal efforts campus wide. Presented by Dale Link
- 8. D. Bergman provided overview of injury statistics in general and bloodborne pathogen exposures.
