I write in follow up to our September 6, 2018 telephone conversation. During that call, you requested a written update to the August 10, 2018 letter The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill provided in response to your July 31, 2018 letter pertaining to OSH Complaint 209617158.

As stated in our initial response letter, the University is committed to protecting the health and safety of all members of the University community, including employees, students, and visitors. The University's Departments of Environment, Health and Safety (EHS), Facilities Services, and Art have completed the review of the Art Lab paint booth and have determined that the paint booth will remain closed until a new paint control system can be designed and constructed. We expect that the new paint control system will be installed during the third quarter of 2019.

In the interim, EHS and the Art Department will review each specific art project and determine the appropriate safety measures and controls.
