This letter serves to release The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill from further annual monitoring of the restored wetland at its Bingham Facility. This restoration and subsequent three years of monitoring was conducted in order to comply with the requirements of a Notice of Violation issued to the University in 2010 because of illegal wetlands fill.

Based on the site visit conducted by Cherri Smith on February 6, 2014, the wetland has been successfully restored and more than meets the requirement that there be 320 trees per acre surviving three years after planting. We appreciate the responsible manner in which you handled this violation.
