Friends and neighbors:

Thanks to those who attended what we feel was a very positive meeting about the Bingham Facility on Tuesday night. We realize we have far to go, but we think we are off to a good start and appreciate your comments and questions.

As an update, the wastewater treatment systems have been shut down at Bingham. Wastewater generated at the facility now will be hauled to OWASA for treatment. With the concerns about traffic and safety expressed by neighbors in mind, we have asked the haulers to do their work in a way that will minimize disruption on Orange Chapel Clover Garden Road. We anticipate that the pump and haul operation should require no more than one or two trucks on the road each week.

We have also attached a recent letter from DENR, which asks us to supply details about our long-term solution for wastewater treatment at Bingham and more information about the existing system. We will comply with these requests and will share the information with you when we do.
